NOTICE REGARDING ELIGIBILITY FOR STD 11 STUDENTS (A.Y. 2024-25) who appeared for the Std. 10 Board Examination from any Board other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education

As per MSBSHSE, Pune Circular dated September 23, 2024 Ref. No. रा. मं. / संशोधन /यो. प्र. /२०२४-२५/३३३८, students who have secured admission into Std. 11 of this College for A. Y. 2024-25 and had appeared for the Std. 10 Board Examination from any Board other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE) are hereby being informed that their admission into Std. 11 of this College is **provisional** and is subject to receipt of Eligibility Certificate to be issued by MSBSHSE,

Application Process:

Such students are required to carry out the following procedure at the earliest

- Fill up (completely and correctly) and submit the Eligibility application form to the College for this purpose jointly to be signed by the student and parent.
- Attach necessary documents: Migration Certificate (Original), and Std. 10 Mark List and Passing Certificate (Original + copies, original will be returned) and School/College Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate (copy)
- Pay applicable Eligibility fees which are forwarded by the College to the Board.

1	Regular Fee (Sept 01 to Sept. 30)	Rs.1,000 /-	Rs.1,500 /-
2	Late Fee (Oct 01 to Nov. 30)	Rs.2,100 /-	Rs.2,600/-
3	Very Late Fee (from Dec 01 onwards)	Rs. 2100 + Rs. 20 per day	Rs. 2600 + Rs. 20 per day

Note:

- **Provisional admission of students into Std 11 who do not submit eligibility application or whose eligibility is rejected by the Board will be cancelled by the College and the Std. 11 result of such candidates will not be declared.**
- Applications are submitted by the College to MSBSHSE who is authorised to grant or reject the Eligibility application. The College is not responsible for the same.
- Fees paid by the candidate including late fee if any applicable towards eligibility is non-refundable irrespective of whether Eligibility is granted to the applicant or rejected.
- Delay in submission of complete application including fees for eligibility by the candidate fees will in turn cause delay in processing of the application by the board. Therefore it may be too late to carry out any further process after obtaining the Eligibility late or learning at a later stage that the application has been rejected. In such situations the College will not be responsible in any manner whatsoever for the consequences arising out of the same.
